For ASR XL there are 13 revised and 12 waiting which comes to 25 in total (20.6%). There are another 14 that we feel need revised but are waiting to see a revision surgeon – a number of these are urgent. If all 14 of these are revised that will bring the revision number to (13+12+14) 39 (32%).

Then there are a further 53 (43.8%) of patients about whom we have some concerns.

Then there are 26 (21.5%) who are pain free and finally 3 patients that are deceased

For ASR resurfacing much smaller numbers of patients and interestingly 23 of them or 71% are pain free as compared to 21.5% of the ASR XLs
