Dear Magnus,

On special request of DePuy Netherlands I send you the serum concentrations of my two painful ASR patients.

patient 1, male 58 yr, oncologic surgeon in my hospital, operated in may 2005

patient 2, male 42 yr, operated in jan 2006.

Both recovered good after the operation, X rays normal, good position, no clinical or radiological impingement.

Patient 1, pain since 3 month: Chromium: 57,69 (0-40) en Cobalt 27,0 (0-11)

Patient 2, pain since 2 month, Chromium: 44,23 (0-40) en Cobalt 20,7 (0-11)

The concentration does not seem to be extremely high, but it seems strange that after more than 1 year (steady state) the concentrations of patient 1 still are on this level, especially because he is not symptom free.

CRP and other infection parameters are normal, in patient 1 Tc scan is normal.

Keep me informed when you find a reason for my clinical problems.

Did you already find some special in my retrieved cup.
